Welcome to the Calow and Brimington Practice

We work as a team of doctors, practice nurses and health care assistants supported by the administration staff, dispensers and managers. The surgery at Calow has a dispensary and patients who do not have a pharmacy within a mile of their address can obtain medication from the practice.

Registering with us

We are currently accepting new patients if you are within our practice area. Please ask a member of the admin team if you are unsure and then complete a registration form.

We expect most patients to be able to make their way to either surgery if they need to see a Doctor, Nurse or Health Care Professional. The Administration Team will do their best to book your appointment at the surgery of your choice but there may be times when this is not possible.

Appointments

Our appointment system allows patients to book on the day or in advance for all Clinicians. Practice Nurses and Healthcare Assistants can be booked up to 12 weeks in advance. If you wish to have a chaperone at any appointment please ask and this can be provided.

Online Access

If you would like access to our online services please ask at reception and provide photo ID. This can be done on registering at the practice. You can book appointments online this can be done at 08.00am for same day appointments or anytime for pre-bookable appointments. You can request medication online and this can be sent

electronically to a chemist of your choice. You can also have access to your coded and full medical records.

Extended Access Appointments

We now offer appointments with GPs, practice nurses and health care assistants Monday - Friday 07.00-20.00 and Saturdays 08.00-17.30 these appointments are available to book here at our practice or at local practices within the Chesterfield area. Please ask a member of the team.

Home Visits

Home visits can be arranged for patients who are too ill to get to surgery. Please try and request this before 11.00am on the day. Requests made after 11.00am must be for genuine emergencies only.

Prescriptions

Prescriptions can be requested in 3 ways:

- Online
- In person
- On the prescription order line 01246 588860 09.00 4.00pm Mon-Fri

Prescriptions will be ready within 2 working days so please allow plenty of time for your order to be processed. We can send your prescription electronically to a pharmacy of your choice please let a member of reception know.

Test Results

You can ring to check your test results with a member of the admin team, these can be accessed between 2.30-4.30pm. For confidentiality we can only discuss these with the patient unless you have completed a medical record access form please ask at reception.

Please note: If the test has been requested by the hospital you will need to refer back to the hospital for these results.

Blood tests are done before 3.30pm to be sent off to the hospital. Please note we can do blood tests for the hospital at the surgery if you have a form however if we are fully booked you must book your appointment at the hospital.

Care Coordination Team

Our care coordination team are here to help and sign post you to different services you may need. If you receive care or are a carer yourself they

can refer on and help with your ongoing needs. They are also key team members helping provide high quality palliative care for our patients.

District Nurses

The district nurse team are employed by DCHS and work with the practice. They visit patients and hold clinics for patients with complex wound needs. They also provide palliative care for terminally ill patients in their home. Their contact number is 01332 564900.
